How to use

Preparation

Please wash your hands. Wash the area around the urethral opening with soap and water in a circular motion starting from the urethra (urinary passage) to the outer edges of the penis. This should be done only once.

Make sure you are completely ready to proceed with catheterization before you open the packaging. Complete the catheterization without undue delay and remove the catheter upon emptying the bladder.



Opening method 1: Peel open the packaging. Take out the catheter.






Opening method 2:

Stick the packaging to a horizontal surface using the upper part of the adhesive label on the backside. Peel open the packaging. Take out the catheter.




Twist to open the catheter.



Drain the water through the drainage end in the toilet or sink before catheterization.




Alternatively, a urine bag can be attached to the connector end and the water will empty directly into the urine bag.



Glide your fingers down the sleeve to drain the last drops of water.

Insertion




While supporting your penis, guide the tip of the catheter into the opening of the urinary passage.

Once the tip is lodged in the urinary passage, make sure you hold your penis and the turquoise handle in the same hand.

With your other hand, start pulling the sleeve to insert the catheter towards the bladder.



Once urine starts to flow stop inserting the catheter.




When urine stops flowing, pull the catheter out about 1-2 cm. If urine starts flowing again, wait until it stops. Then pull the catheter out 1-2 cm again. When your bladder is empty, remove the catheter.

Disposal



After use, the catheter can be re-closed by rejoining the two turquoise handles together.



Return the catheter to the packaging.



Use the sticker on the backside to re-close the packaging.

The product is intended for single use only and should be disposed of in accordance with local guidelines, e.g. with normal household waste.

Do not flush the product down the toilet.


